When we look up at night, we can see many stars in the sky. They look very beautiful, but do you think they really are? One day, my science teacher taught me about "space debris." DHave you ever heard of it?

Space debris is pieces of broken satellites or rockets that were used in the past. When rockets come back to the Earth, some parts of them are 2(take) off and left in space. Also, astronauts throw away their tools or gloves ) their activities. Some of you may think that space is infinite, so space debris is not such a big problem. Many people in the past thought <u>4</u>that way, too. Actually, that's not true.

What is happening in space? ⑤(in / there / many accidents / are) space because the amount of space debris is increasing. In 2021, for example, space debris hit some parts of ISS (International Space Station). ( fact, space debris moves much faster than a bullet. <u>Oyou can imagine how dangerous it is.</u> If it hits astronauts or the ISS, they can't work in space and we can't explore space anymore. If space debris hits weather satellites, we cannot get any information about the future weather. I think that will make our lives inconvenient.

Ⅲ 次のナイチンゲール (Florence Nightingale) についてのスピーチを読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Today, I'm going to talk about my future dream. I decided to enter Shoin High School because it has a nursing course. When I was a junior high school student, I read a book about a very famous nurse, Florence Nightingale. Her life and ideas had a big influence on me.

Nightingale was born in 1820 in Italy ①( was / while / traveling / her family). After her family returned to England, she started to study many subjects taught to her by her parents and other teachers. Her family was very rich. Her favorite subjects were languages and mathematics.

One day, she saw many poor and sick people in a village (②) she visited as a charity worker. This experience shocked her deeply, and she could not forget ③it. When she (④), she wanted to become a nurse in England. But her family didn't support her career choice. At that time, the social status of nurses was not high. However, her family finally understood her passion; she truly wanted to help sick people.

In 1854, Nightingale went to a hospital in a war area as a nurse. There were many injured soldiers in the hospital. ⑤She took care of them kindly, but some of them died because there wasn't enough medicine. However, she never gave up. She decided to change the situation in the hospital. She cleaned the rooms and prepared clean beds with the help of other nurses. They cooked nutritious meals for the patients. She also collected data on the causes of deaths in the hospital and discovered that the main cause was not war injuries but infectious diseases due to the dirty conditions.

After Nightingale returned from the war area, she opened a nursing school in London. This was the first nursing school in the world. She taught many young nurses. She believed that ⑥( nurses / patients / with / needed) special knowledge.
